Resolution Rejecting the "CSCU Organizational Study" Supplied by NCHEMS

- WHEREAS A Regent characterized this document as outdated and incomplete during a 5 December 2024 meeting.
- WHEREAS The document compared CSCU pay and benefits with compensation in anti-union "right to work" states (campuses which, therefore, can not be considered peers).
- WHEREAS The document exhibits bias with respect to enrollments and only reports negative evidence, omitting recent positive increases in CSCU enrollments.
- WHEREAS Published journalism documents evidence of major ethical breaches by NCHEMS.
- WHEREAS The document is not comprehensive in discussing valuable benefits created by CSCU, which includes community charitable acts, other acts of service, creative activity and scholarship.
- WHEREAS The document is woefully lacking in considering inequality and its impact on the CSCU mission, including Connecticut's extreme levels of income inequality and K-12 achievement gaps; now, therefore bet it
- RESOLVED The Faculty Advisory Committee to the Board of Regents rejects the CSCU Organizational Study in its entirety.
- RESOLVED We advise that CSCU system office, Board of Regents, General Assembly and Governor to reject the CSCU Organizational Study.
- RESOLVED The shared governance process should always take precedence over the CSCU Organizational Study in determining the future for CSCU.
