CALL TO ORDER

At 2:46 pm BOR Chairman Robinson noted that in accordance with CT General Statute Section 1-225(d), he had called for an emergency meeting of the Board of Regents for Higher Education. The meeting was called on an emergency basis due to the resignation of BOR President Robert A. Kennedy which had been submitted earlier that day. The Chair stated that the President's resignation required immediate action to ensure the continuity of leadership of Connecticut state colleges and universities.

The Chair noted the first matter before the board was to <u>approve President Kennedy's request to</u> waive a 120-day notice of termination requirement set forth within his contract. On a motion by <u>Richard Balducci</u>, with a second by Naomi Cohen, the waiver of termination requirement passed unanimously.

The Chair noted the next item for the Board's consideration was the <u>recommendation to the Governor of a candidate to serve on an interim basis as President of the Board of Regents.</u> In accordance with CGS Section 10a-1b, the Board of Regents is charged with recommending to the Governor the person to serve as President but the Governor makes the final appointment. The governor would then act in his authority to fill President Kennedy's vacancy but consistent with state statutes. The Chair asked for a motion to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing the recommendation.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

On a motion by Richard Balducci, seconded by Yvette Melendez, the Board of Regents voted unanimously to go into executive session at 2:50 p.m. to discuss the matter listed below

• Executive Session to discuss the appointment of a public officer or employee

All members of the Board listed above, along with BOR Secretary Erin Fitzgerald and AAG Henry Salton, were present for the Executive Session.

OPEN SESSION

Executive Session ended at 3:25 p.m. The Board of Regents returned to Open Session at 3:29 p.m. **Appointment of an Interim BOR President** – Chairman Robinson asked for <u>a motion to recommend to the Governor the appointment of Dr. Philip E. Austin to serve as Interim BOR President. Richard Balducci so moved, with a second by Yvette Melendez; with an abstention by Alex Tettey, Jr., the Board voted to approve the recommendation to the Governor</u>

<u>Lawrence DeNardis moved to adjourn; Zac Zeitlin seconded and the special meeting adjourned at 3:33 p.m.</u>
