4) New Business

a) Quick debrief on Vaccine Working Group

A.R. (WCSU) was part of working group suggested by Dr. Gates to research vaccine requirement. Working with Dr. Blitz and others, the looked at the limitations, benefits and cons for students, faculty, and staff. The A.G.'s office said that they needed to look at medical and non-medical exemptions.

P.H. said the Board recognized Dr. Blitz's group and their work. However, due to time constraints, at this time there is only one policy limited to the students only. They must have consent from each bargaining units to include employees. They are working on policy and procedures for employees, vendors, and visitors. The resolution is for all students except for students with medical or non-medical exemptions. They are waiting for clarification of what non-medical exemptions would be.
