  - a. No Cuts to Budget
    - I. Student panels will address the appropriations committee
      - President Ojakian will work with legislators to try to access more grant funding
  - b. PACT Program Proposal Limitations
    - I. Students must apply to the program within a year after graduating college
    - II. Only those students whose families earn less than \$60,000 will be eligible
  - c. Marketing the Program
    - I. The system office will work with community college leaders and public-school principals to advertise the programs to high school students
3. PACT/Debt Free College
  - a. Steve McDonald
    - I. Program Time Limitations
      - Must complete the Community College Program within 3 years or 72 credits
4. Mike Buccilli and Gayle Barrett on case management model at CCs for SF
  - a. Guided Pathways Work
    - Met with focus groups at the community colleges
  - b. Recommendations for Guided Pathways Model
    - Every student will be matched with an advisor
    - 250 students per 1 advisor
    - Help build academic and guided plan towards completion
    - State made \$2 million investment on hiring more advisors
    - Does not eliminate faculty advising (both professional and faculty advisors)
