 - o "Run, Hide, Fight" an emergency management informational video was demonstrated
 - All campuses have access to emergency messaging software that sends a notification to students and faculty should there be a criminal emergency in campus.
 - Since 2015 all schools are required to have and submit emergency plans
- 5. Remarks from CSCU President Mark E. Ojakian
 - O Community Colleges have been allowed to arm security if they so choose.
 - Still no state budget, we are currently working under an executive order from the
 Governor

- There are working groups active on how to better integrate Administrative functions
 throughout the system, also on how to make it easier for students to move through the
 system
- Want to streamline Administration while still maintaining individuals in charge of each campus
- Will be doing regional Townhalls for input
- O Starting pilot programs for getting 4 year degrees at Community Colleges
- O Current Budget Proposal retains all Community College campuses
- o 63,000 Upasses issued!
