
WHEREAS, Periodic reviews of low enrollment degree programs are conducted by the universities in the Connecticut State University System as requested by the Commissioner of the Department of Higher Education, and

WHEREAS, A review of programs by Western Connecticut State University has resulted in a request to discontinue MBA specializations in Accounting and Management, and

WHEREAS, The appropriate University review procedures have been completed and the President of Western Connecticut State University has certified that all currently enrolled students have had appropriate opportunity to graduate, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University System approves the elimination of the Master of Business Administration (MBA) specializations in Accounting and Management at Western Connecticut State University and requests that the Board of Governors for Higher Education be notified of this action.

Discontinuance of the Master of Business Administration (MBA) Specializations in Accounting and Management at Western Connecticut State University

BACKGROUND

A review of low enrollment degree programs was conducted at the Western Connecticut State University System during 1999-2000 as is requested annually by the Commissioner of the Department of Higher Education.

ANALYSIS

The Faculty Senate has recommended the deletion of the MBA Specializations in Accounting and Management at Western Connecticut State University. The President of Western has reviewed and approved this recommendation and has certified that there are no students currently enrolled in this program
