WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works is currently in the process of constructing a new Residence Hall and Parking Garage at the Westside Campus of Western Connecticut State University, and


WHEREAS, The necessary electrical service for the new Residence Hall and Parking Garage does not currently exist, and

WHEREAS, Connecticut Light & Power will install new primary electrical service and a new transformer to serve the electrical needs of the project, and

WHEREAS, Connecticut Light & Power will install, operate and maintain the new primary electrical service and the new transformer, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University System approve an easement to Connecticut Light & Power for the installation of a transformer and primary electrical service to the new Residence Hall and Parking Garage at the Westside Campus of Western Connecticut State University.

ITEM

A utility easement at the Westside campus of Western Connecticut State University to the Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P).

BACKGROUND

The Connecticut Department of Public Works is currently in the process of constructing a new Residence Hall and Parking Garage at the Westside Campus of Western Connecticut State University.

ANALYSIS

The residence hall and parking garage currently under construction at the Westside Campus is located on a part of the campus where no primary electrical service is located. CL&P will install new primary electrical service and a transformer necessary for the operation of the new facility. Installation of the new primary electrical service and transformer will be borne by the utility company. Connecticut Light and Power will also have responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the new service.

In order for this to occur, it is necessary for the Board of Trustees to authorize the Department of Public Works to convey an easement allowing Connecticut Light and Power to install the new primary electrical service to the project. The proposed 10' wide easement will commence at University Boulevard at an existing CL& P easement and run parallel to the new residence hall and will be approximately 5,100 square feet in size.

CHANCELLOR'S RECOMMENDATION

Approve an easement to Connecticut Light and Power Company for the installation of primary electrical service to the new Residence Hall and Parking Garage at the Westside Campus of Western Connecticut State University.
