At the direction of Mr. Walter Kennedy, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the State Colleges, I have been asked to notify you that at their regular meeting on Friday, December 10, 1965, the following salary schedule was adopted for the unclassified personnel (faculty and administration) of the Connecticut State Colleges. This schedule is to be effective July 2, 1965 for the twelve-month positions and September 1, 1965 for the ten-month positions.
