AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION

concerning

Irving Stolberg

June 9, 1972

WHEREAS, Judge M. Joseph Blumenfeld of the United States District Court of Connecticut, in his decision on Civil Suit No. 13,591 of February 29, 1972, ordered the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges to "...promptly offer to reinstate the plaintiff [Irving Stolberg] as a faculty member with tenure at SCSC [Southern Connecticut State College] for the 1972-73 school year with the same seniority as if his contract had been renewed in 1969;...." and,

WHEREAS, the motion to amend findings and judgment filed by the plaintiff, Irving Stolberg, was denied by Judge Blumenfeld on April 26, 1972, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the President of Southern Connecticut State College to write to Mr. Stolberg offering to reinstate him as a faculty member with tenure at Southern Connecticut State College, effective for the 1972-73 school year.
