## RESOLUTION

concerning

Residence Classification at the State Colleges

July 13, 1973

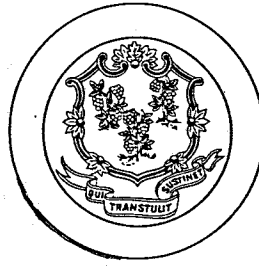
WHEREAS, The 1973 Connecticut General Assembly has provided in Public Act 474 new definitions governing the classification of students for tuition purposes at public institution of higher education, be it

RESOLVED, The Board of Trustees for State Colleges, in order to provide uniform regulations regarding residence in the assessment of tuition and fees, adopts the following as:

### Regulations Regarding Residence Classification

- a. All students, before registering for classes for the first time at a State College, must file an affidavit of residence, on forms prescribed by the College. On the basis of this information, each entering student will be classified initially as a "Connecticut" or an "Out-of-State" student.
- b. The status of each student will be determined by the definitions mandated in Public Act 474 (1973).
- c. A student whose residence status changes or whose original classification is appealed must file a "Residence Reclassification Affidavit" inclusive of the required information.
- d. The failure of a student to disclose fully and accurately all facts relating to his residence status shall be grounds for suspension or expulsion.

## **RESIDENCY RECLASSIFICATION AFFIDAVIT**

Any full-time student classified as an out-of-state resident who feels that he or she qualifies as a resident of Connecticut may request a change of classification.

Connecticut General Statute Sec. 10a - 29 specifies that the residence of an unemancipated person is that of his or her parent. In addition it specifies that one must maintain a clearly established residence in Connecticut for at least six months to establish a new legal residence; that an emancipated person who can provide evidence of residence in Connecticut is eligible for classification as an in-state student for tuition purposes; and makes certain provisions for special cases.

Note: The establishment of residency in Connecticut for purposes of voting is not alone sufficient for reclassification for tuition purposes.

RESIDENCE RECLASSIFICATION AFFIDAVIT  
(Change Request)

Any student classified as an out-of-state resident who feels he/she qualifies as a bona fide resident of Connecticut may request a change of classification. Public Act 474 specifies: that the domicile of an unemancipated person is that of his parent; that residence in this state for a period of not less than six months is required for the establishment of a new domicile; that an emancipated person who provides evidence of domicile in Connecticut is eligible for classification as an in-state student for tuition purposes; and makes certain provisions for special cases.
