RESOLVED: That the Commission for Higher Education approve for planning an Administrative Sciences Program which would lead to the degree of Master of Science in Administration (M.S.A.) at Western Connecticut State College, with the following conditions:

1. The proposed program shall be clearly identified as not being a professional program, but rather one on the master level leading to a master of science degree in Administrative Sciences;
2. There is no intention by WesConn to modify the M.S.A. into an M.B.A. type program, nor use it as a basis for designing an M.B.A.; and
3. There will be an assessment and review of graduate programs in administration at the Western Connecticut State College campus (including the M.B.A. program currently undertaken through the University of Connecticut at the Danbury campus) as well as the proposed program in administration and a report to the Commission for Higher Education on this matter by the president through the Board of Trustees for State Colleges. This report is to be made no later than September, 1977.
