AMENDING RESOLUTION

concerning

INCREASE IN COLLEGE GENERAL FEE, SCR#77-13

April 1, 1977

WHEREAS, Section 10-116 of the General Statutes provides that the Board of Trustees for State Colleges, subject to the approval of the Commission for Higher Education, shall fix fees for such purposes as the Board deems necessary, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees by Resolution #77-13, dated February 4, 1977, did authorize adjustments in the General Fee not to exceed the following schedule:

- \$140 per academic year at Central Connecticut State College
- 110 per academic year at Eastern Connecticut State College
- 110 per academic year at Southern Connecticut State College
- 110 per academic year at Western Connecticut State College, and

WHEREAS, The Commission for Higher Education by resolution dated March 1, 1977, did approve the schedule adopted by the Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, The Student Advisory Board after careful study of the situation has accepted as proper the maximum fees listed above except that it recommends the General Fee for Eastern Connecticut State College be \$99, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That Resolution #77-13, dated February 4, 1977, be amended to establish the following schedule for General Fees, effective for the fall semester of 1977:

- Central Connecticut State College from \$126.18 to \$140 per academic year
- Eastern Connecticut State College from \$81.00 to \$99 per academic year
- Southern Connecticut State College from \$97.00 to \$110 per academic year
- Western Connecticut State College from \$69.00 to \$110 per academic year.
