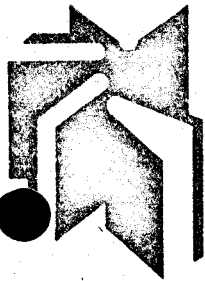

I want to thank you again for your assistance in getting the baccalaureate program in Journalism approved for Southern Connecticut State College.

Since the BHE resolution refers only to a "baccalaureate," I presume that the campus will have the authority to offer the major which was proposed to the BHE as either a B.S. or B.A. depending on the general education requirements which are observed. Southern, as you know, has two different general education tracks, the one for the B.A. degree requiring more foreign language. The major in Journalism would be the same whether the student pursued the B.S. or the B.A.

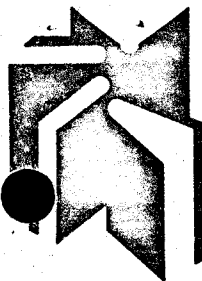

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
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
