

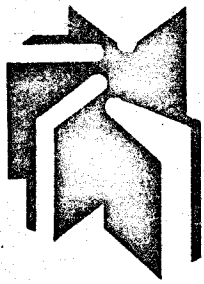



SUBJECT	Rehabilitate Exterior Walls - College Union		

Since our last submission of repair and renovation projects for Auxiliary Services buildings on November 2, 1978-- approved by the Board of Trustees--a rapid deterioration problem in the exterior walls of the College Union has suddenly become highly visible. It is essential, therefore, that if funds can be found within the Reserve for Major Repairs, Central Office, Auxiliary Services Fund, that the attached project request to rehabilitate exterior walls - College Union be approved by the Board of Trustees in time to commence this project in early spring, 1980. Although the project cost appears high, that cost will rapidly escalate the longer the rehabilitation is deferred.
