## RESOLUTION

concerning

AUTHORIZATION TO COMPLETE PAYMENT OF INTERN  
at  
WESTERN CONNECTICUT STATE COLLEGE

December 7, 1979

- WHEREAS, Mr. Ara Shishmanian was hired as a Graduate Intern in the College Union at Western Connecticut State College effective August 28, 1978, under a job prospectus in which the stipend for the position was advertised as \$3,550 for the academic year, which is a period of nine months and
- WHEREAS, The conditions under which Mr. Shishmanian was hired were controlled by Resolution 76-52, dated June 2, 1976, which limited the monthly stipend for Graduate Interns who are in the first year of service to \$355 per month and
- WHEREAS, The payment of \$355 per month for a period of nine months would result in a salary for the academic year of \$3195 which is \$355 less than promised in the job prospectus and
- WHEREAS, Resolution 79-87, dated August 2, 1979, limits the monthly stipend for Graduate Interns who are in the first year of service to \$380 per month which provides a salary of \$3420 for the nine month academic year; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That, Resolution 76-52 and Resolution 79-87 notwithstanding, the President of Western Connecticut State College is authorized to pay Mr. Ara Shishmanian an additional sum of \$355 in order to bring his salary for the academic year to \$3,550 as stated in the prospectus.

## INTERNS IN THE CONNECTICUT STATE COLLEGES

June 4, 1976

- WHEREAS, The student centers of the Connecticut State Colleges are established to provide a wide variety of services and activities for the entire campus community, and
- WHEREAS, The hours of operation of these facilities are extensive and the program requirements many, and
- WHEREAS, These services cannot at all times be reasonably provided by normal professional staff complements, and
- WHEREAS, There is a nationally recognized program for the professional training of individuals desirous of career work in student centers, and
- WHEREAS, Universities and colleges throughout the nation provide for "internship" programs culminating in the training of professionals for student centers, now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the position of State College Intern is authorized for use with students in graduate programs, and with remuneration in the form of:
1. Waiver of fees for up to fifteen credit hours per academic year,
  2. Stipend not to exceed \$355. per month of service during the first year, and not to exceed \$405. per month of service during the second year.

and be it further

- RESOLVED, That each College shall be authorized one such intern for each 1000 full-time equivalent students or major fraction thereof.

### RESOLUTION

concerning

INTERNS IN THE CONNECTICUT STATE COLLEGES

August 2, 1979

WHEREAS, State College Resolution #76-52 dated June 4, 1976 established the position of State College Intern for use in Student Centers and further provided for remuneration for services rendered, and

WHEREAS, The internships have been highly successful from the perspective of the educational program of the student interns as well as from the perspective of the colleges' need for services, and

WHEREAS, Both the student interns and the colleges could benefit from permitting the internships to be tenable in all student affairs areas, and

WHEREAS, The need for an increase in remuneration has become evident, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That State College Resolution #76-52 is hereby repealed, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the position of State College Intern is authorized for use in all student affairs areas for students in graduate programs with remuneration in the form of:

1. Waiver of fees for up to 18 credit hours per year, and
2. Stipends not to exceed \$380 per month of service during the first year, and not to exceed \$434 per month of service during the second year.

RESOLVED, That each College shall be authorized one such intern for each 1,000 full-time equivalent students or major fraction thereof.
