RESOLUTION

concerning

NEGOTIATION OF PENSION PROVISIONS

November 7, 1980

- WHEREAS, The collective bargaining agreements for both the teaching faculty and the administrative faculty are reopened in this fiscal year, 1980-81, for the purpose of negotiating pensions, and
- WHEREAS, The Director of Labor Relations of the Department of Administrative Services has indicated that many unions, including those at the State Colleges, are forming a coalition to negotiate pensions, and
- WHEREAS, Under Section 5-278 of the General Statutes, the Board of Trustees has exclusive authority to bargain with the unclassified professional employees of the State Colleges, and
- WHEREAS, In an effort to meet the unions in coalition, the Director of Labor Relations of the Department of Administrative Services is seeking to assemble a management team consisting of negotiators from each affected management group, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That Dr. Michael Pernal, Dean of Personnel Administration at Eastern Connecticut State College, be designated as the negotiator for the State Colleges to serve on the coalition of management bargainners for the sole purpose of negotiating pension provisions.
