FEE SCHEDULE AND REFUND POLICY

March 5, 1982

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State Colleges by Resolution #79-148, dated December 7, 1979, revised the Fee Schedule and Refund Policy effective for the Fall 1980 semester, and

WHEREAS, The Re-admissions Binder paid by returning students no longer is necessary, be it

RESOLVED, That the Fee Schedule and Refund Policy adopted by the Board in Resolution #79-148, dated December 7, 1979, is hereby rescinded, and is to be superseded by the attached Fee Schedule and Refund Policy, effective for the Fall 1982 semester, and be it further

RESOLVED, That, under circumstances beyond the control of the individual or in cases where attendance has been denied by the College, the President may authorize the refunding of fees otherwise designated as non-refundable.



December 7, 1979

- WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State Colleges by Resolution #77-3, dated January 19, 1977, and as amended by SCR #77-71 dated July 15, 1977, revised the Fee Schedule and Refund Policy effective for the Fall 1977 semester, and
- WHEREAS, The current schedule for the collection of non-refundable deposits for the State College Fee and for Housing does not allow sufficient lead time for course scheduling and assignment of available housing space, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Fee Schedule and Refund Policy adopted by the Board in Resolution #77-3, dated January 19, 1977, and as amended by SCR #77-71, dated July 15, 1977, is hereby rescinded, and is to be superseded by the attached Fee Schedule and Refund Policy, effective the Fall 1980 semester, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That, under circumstances beyond the control of the individual or in cases where attendance has been denied by the College, the President may authorize the refunding of fees otherwise designated as non-refundable.
