RESOLUTION

concerning

TUITION AT THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

May 4, 1984

- WHEREAS, The General Assembly has passed an appropriation act based on the provisions of a bill before that body which will establish for the Connecticut State University a Tuition Fund into which all Tuition collected is to be deposited and from which certain operating costs of the Connecticut State University are to be met, and
- WHEREAS, It appears that the appropriation act is assured of the Governor's approval and that the act establishing the Tuition Fund is assured of General Assembly passage without significant change, and
- WHEREAS, Tuition collected using current rates is not sufficient to support the Tuition Fund portion of the 1984-85 operating budget of the Connecticut State University as passed by the General Assembly, be it
- RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1984, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to Connecticut State University students shall be increased as follows:



RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section 10a-67 of the General Statutes and those of Board Resolution #80-113 as amended by Board Resolution #82-53, and subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1984, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to nonresident students who are enrolled in the Connecticut State University through the New England Regional Student Program shall be \$406 for undergraduate and \$513 for graduate students.
