WHEREAS, It is proposed by the President of Southern Connecticut State University to change the name of Southern's School of Business Economics to the School of Business, and



RESOLVED, That the Trustees of the Connecticut State University hereby approve the change of name of the School of Business Economics at Southern Connecticut State University to the School of Business, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the change of name to School of Business shall not be effective until confirmed by approval of the Connecticut Board of Governors of Higher Education.
