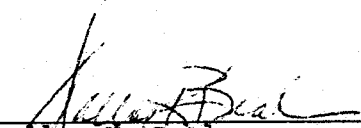

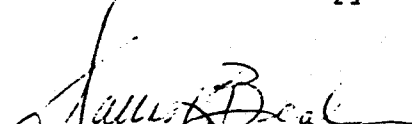

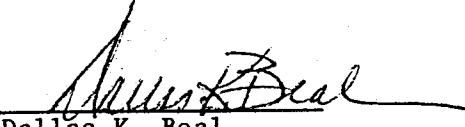
THE SIGNING OF LEGAL DOCUMENTS TO EFFECT THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT LOAN ACCOUNTS
