TUITION AT THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

July 21, 1989

WHEREAS, Tuition collected using current rates will not be sufficient to support the Tuition Fund portion of the 1990-91 operating budget of the Connecticut State University, be it


RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1990, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to Connecticut State University students shall be increased as follows:

Graduate	575	660
Nonresidents:		
Undergraduate	\$1,490	\$1,715
Graduate	1,600	1,840

and be it

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section 10a-67 of the General Statutes and those of Board Resolution #80-113 as amended by Board Resolution #82-53, and subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1990, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to nonresident students who are enrolled in the Connecticut State University through the New England Regional Student Program shall be \$660 for undergraduate and \$825 for graduate students.
