concerning

THE USE OF UNIVERSITY STUDENT CENTER VENDING MACHINE INCOME
AT SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

September 7, 1990

WHEREAS, Southern Connecticut State University plans to offer vending machine services in the main dining room of the University Student Center while the food preparation facilities housed in the center undergo major renovation, and

WHEREAS, Additional costs will be incurred by the University in offering vending machine services including the installation of new electrical and plumbing utilities and routine cleaning of the dining room area, and


WHEREAS, Board Resolution #84-208 provides that profit from vending machines located in student centers will be deposited in the Student Activity Fund and used for student center purposes, and

WHEREAS, The loss of the cash food service revenue from the student center during the renovation may adversely affect auxiliary services fund resources of the University and subsequently student fees, be it

RESOLVED, That, retroactive to September 1, 1990 and continuing through March 1, 1991, Southern Connecticut State University shall be permitted to deposit all revenues generated by vending machines located in the main dining room of the University Student Center in the Auxiliary Services Fund, and be it

RESOLVED, That, such revenues shall be used solely for the purpose of offsetting costs associated with the operation of food vending machines in the student center and any other costs directly related to food service operations at Southern Connecticut State University during this period.
