

AMENDMENT OF BOARD RESOLUTION 97-7
REGARDING STUDENT ACCIDENT AND SICKNESS
INSURANCE FEE SCHEDULE

May 9, 1997

- WHEREAS, Board Resolution 97-7 set forth the fees and other requirements of the student accident and sickness insurance program for full-time and certain matriculated part-time students, and
- WHEREAS, Said Resolution references waivers of mandatory coverage under the student accident and sickness insurance program, and
- WHEREAS, The University General Fee, which includes the fee for accident insurance, is waived by policy or collective bargaining agreement for all full-time SUOAF-AFSCME employees who are full-time students and for all full-time CSU Management and Confidential Professional employees and their spouses and unmarried dependents under the age of 25 who are full-time students, therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the requirement to have mandatory accident insurance coverage for full-time students is hereby waived for all full-time SUOAF-AFSCME employees who are full-time students and for all full-time CSU Management and Confidential Professional employees and their spouses and unmarried dependents under the age of 25 who are full-time students.

Amendment Of Board Resolution 97-7 Regarding Student Accident And Sickness Insurance Fee Schedule

BACKGROUND

Board Resolution 97-7 sets forth fees, waivers and other requirements of the accident and sickness insurance program for full-time and certain part-time students. The only applicable waiver at this time is a waiver of the sickness insurance program where evidence of alternate coverage is provided. Through a general review of fee waivers, it has been determined that a waiver of the accident insurance program should be granted to those full-time students who do not pay the University General Fee, which includes the accident insurance fee.

ANALYSIS

By policy or collective bargaining agreement, full-time SUOAF-AFSCME employees who are full-time students and full-time Management and Confidential Professional Personnel and their spouses and unmarried dependents who are full-time students do not pay the University General Fee. Such fee contains the accident insurance fee. Accordingly, the requirement to have mandatory accident insurance should be waived for these students.

CHANCELLOR'S RECOMMENDATION

To approve the amendment to Board Resolution 97-7 concerning the student accident and sickness insurance fee schedule.
